Available Positions:

Senior Staff

To be eligible for the senior staff role, one must be 18. As a member of the Senior Staff, you are a resident staff member and reside at camp from Sunday noon until Friday evening. The position is for eight weeks of the summer, although staff have time off at different points in the day and are permitted to leave camp if necessary. The Senior Staff member is directly responsible for their campers and cabin or will be able to lead an activity such as archery, boating, nature crafts, etc.

Kids Kamp Counselor

To be eligible for the role of Kids Kamp Counselor, one must be 18 years old. The Kids Kamp work day is 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The Kids Kamp is not an overnight camp and, therefore, not a resident position. Though Kids Kamp Counselors are not required to leave Camp by 5:30 p.m., housing will only be guaranteed with prior approval. The Kids Kamp Counselor is responsible for their day campers.

Administrative Positions

Already have camp experience? Consider applying for our Assistant Summer Camp Director or our Day Camp Director. Job descriptions can be found on our website employment page. Want to work at camp but not directly with children? Camp also hires an office manager and a maintenance/pool person for the summer. With the exception of the Asst. Summer Camp Director, these positions can be resident or non-resident.

Remember, housing, meals, utilities, and other living expenses are fully covered. This translates to extra money at the end of the season when returning to school or venturing out for the next job.

What's In It for You?

Your camp experience is a great way to showcase the skills you have learned to future employers. Many essential career skills needed for success are fostered at Camp, including communication, collaboration, work ethic, leadership, and social skills.

By working at Camp, you will have access to a great network of camp alumni. Many would be more than happy to help with job and career preparation.
